

Help Your Child Become a Reader

Bag-a-Book

Each school day your child will bring home a book bag with two books in it. Each evening we would like to encourage you to read the books with your child. We ask that each evening/weekend you:

Read the books

Write in the journal - Write a comment in the journal log.

(Adults make the comment and write it. Children will get their turn in school)

Bag the books - Together put the books back into the bag for school the next day.

Return the books – Each day (whether or not you have read the books) return the books to school so another child may have a different bag the following day.
